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# Testing the GMS Built-in Services

Now that you have configured the built-in services, it's time to test them.

#### Prerequisites

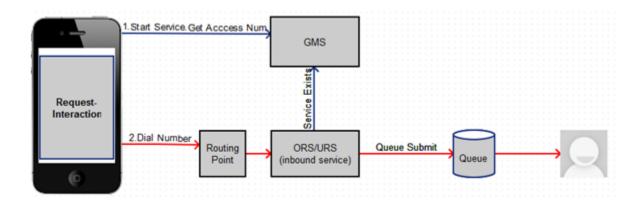
You must have completed the following:

- 1. Configured the dependencies.
- 2. Configured the built-in services.

#### **Important**

In the following scenarios, if the GMS Match fails, there will be no user data attached to the interaction.

## Scenario request-interaction Test Procedure



- 1. On the Agent Desktop:
  - · Log in agent.
  - Make voice ready.
- 2. Using the Javascript sample: Service Management UI > Lab > Sample:
  - · Log in agent and make voice ready.

- Set Contact# = <customer phone from which call will be dialed>
- Set Scenario = REQUEST-INTERACTION
- Click Connect.
- Dial displayed Number to Call.
- 3. Expected result:
  - Treatment is played.
  - Call is routed to agent.
  - Toast is displayed with attached data.
  - Call is connected to agent.
  - For a successful GMS call, GMS\_MatchResult = SUCCESS is displayed in the agent desktop as attached data.
