Changes Take Effect: After start/restart

Specifies the address of the load balancer for a cluster of Backend servers. If specified, this value is used as the address for delivering events from the Frontend Server to the Backend Server. If specified, this option **overrides** connections defined in a server's connection tab. If not specified, you must set a connection between the Frontend Server and Backend server directly (direct configuration method should only be used for development and testing).
