htcc base url

Default Value: Empty

Valid Values: Interaction Recording Web Services load balancer URL (or Web Services server URL if you're using version 8.5.210.02 or earlier); for example; http://<Interaction Recording Web Services

Changes Take Effect: After restart

Specifies the HTCC Base URL.

htcc_http_timeout

Default Value: 20

Valid Values: Integers > 0

Changes Take Effect: After restart

Specifies the HTTP timeout value (in seconds) for HTCC API.

htcc_keepalive_interval

Default Value: 60

Valid Values: Integers > 0

Changes Take Effect: After restart

The interval in seconds the Plugin will be sending a request to HTCC API to keep the user session alive.

httpclient.cookiepolicy
