TAlternateCall

Description

On behalf of the telephony object specified by the parameter `dn`, places the active call specified by the parameter `current_conn_id` on hold and connects the call specified by the parameter `held_conn_id`.

Parameters

Name	Description
<code>server</code>	Local server handle to the T-Server in question.
<code>dn</code>	Directory number of the telephony object on whose behalf the calls are requested to be swapped.
<code>held_conn_id</code>	Connection identifier of the call that is requested to be connected.
<code>current_conn_id</code>	Connection identifier of the active call that is requested to be placed on hold.
<code>reasons</code>	A pointer to a data structure that provides additional information associated with this action.
<code>extensions</code>	A pointer to an additional data structure.
