What's New

This release contains the following new features and enhancements:

- E-mail Server Java (ESJ) now allows sending emails on behalf of a user that is different from the configured outbound mailbox account. This feature is enabled by using the new configuration option **allow-delegate** introduced in the **[smtp-client]** section. When this new option is set to `true`, the **From** field in an outgoing email is assigned with the value in the **From** key-value pair in an email interaction. **Note:** This feature is applicable only when the Graph API is used. (ESR-15865)
