## Resolved Issues

This release contains the following resolved issues:

---

T-Server/SIP Server can now process postponed configuration events asynchronously while reconnecting to Configuration Server. To enable asynchronous processing of postponed configuration events, set the **tconf-enable-async-processing** option to `true` in the **TServer** section.

### **tconf-enable-async-processing**

Default Value: `false`

Valid Values: `true`, `false`

Change Takes Effect: Immediately

The option defines how T-Server/SIP Server processes postponed configuration events from Configuration Server. If the option is set to `true`, T-Server/SIP Server processes postponed events asynchronously while reconnecting to Configuration Server. If the option is set to `false`, T-Server/SIP Server processes postponed configuration events in synchronous manner. This option does not affect the T-Server/SIP Server startup procedure. (TS-12049)
