Server2Go is a pre-configured, portable WAMP that allows you to temporarily create a local web server with all applications required to view a local MediaWiki instance. For more information, including license and configuration details, please visit the Server2Go and WampServer websites.

To deploy Genesys Offline Documentation:

- 1. On a Windows Server host, open the **Documentation** folder of the product DVD or IP package.
- 2. Copy the **GenesysDocumentation.rar** file to the host.
- 3. Extract the contents of the **GenesysDocumentation.rar** file to the folder where you want to maintain

Genesys Offline Documentation.

Note: All files and programs are self-contained. There are no additional installation or dependencies required.

Starting Genesys Offline Documentation

To start the Server2Go application, locate and run the **GenesysDocumentation.exe** file from the root folder in which the contents of the GenesysDocumentation.rar file were extracted. The GenesysDocumentation.exe file automatically starts the required Apache and MySQL servers and opens a portable Google Chrome web browser windeow to display Genesys Offline Documentation.

Stopping Genesys Offline Documentation

There are two ways you can stop the Server2Go application and related processes:

- Close the portable Google Chrome window. This triggers the Server2Go application to end related processes and shut down at the same time.
 - **Note**: Server2Go does not shut down if KeepRunningAfterBrowserClose=1 is set in the **pms config.ini** file.
- Locate the Server2Go icon in the notification area of your Windows taskbar, right-click the icon, and select **Close Genesys Offline Documentation**.

Configuring GAX to Access Genesys Offline Documentation

Prerequisite: You have extracted and configured the Genesys Offline Documentation package, as explained in the section Deploying Genesys Offline Documentation, above.

- 1. In Genesys Administrator Extension, open Configuration Manager.
- 2. Hover over the **Environment** image and select **Applications** in the pop-up menu. The **Applications** list appears.
- 3. Select the GAX Application object and click **Edit**. The Application details page appears.
- 4. Click the **Application Options** tab to see configuration options for the GAX Application object.
- 5. Scroll to the **general** section. Do one of the following:
 - · If the help external url option exists:
 - i. Select the **help_external_url** option.
 - ii. In the **Edit** pop-up menu, change the text in the **Value** field to the IP address and port of the Windows Server host that contains the Genesys Offline Documentation package. Refer to the Configuration Options chapter of the *Genesys Administrator Extension Deployment Guide* for more information about this configuration option.
 - If the help external url option does not exist:
 - i. Click Add.

- ii. In the **New** pop-up menu, enter the following information:
 - In the **Section** field, enter general.
 - In the **Key** field, enter help_external_url.
 - In the **Value** field, enter the IP address and port of the Windows Server host that contains the Genesys Offline Documentation package.

• Click Save.

Known Issues and Recommendations

Genesys Administrator Extension

The Known Issues and Recommendations section is a cumulative list for all 8.5.x releases of Genesys Administrator Extension. This section provides the latest information on known issues and recommendations associated with this product. It includes information on when individual items were found and, if applicable, corrected. The Resolved Issues section for each release describes the corrections and may list additional issues that were corrected without first being documented as Known Issues.

Recommendation: When GAX starts from GA (or SCI), Windows Services shows that the function has stopped. To run GAX as an exe service and view the synchronized status in Windows Services, GA, or GAX, you must manually edit the GAX application in Configuration Server and update the command line to gaxservice.exe and the command line arguments to, for example, -service GAX64 -immediate - app GAX application name.

Recommendation: If you are using the Voice Platform plugin for GAX, GAX might not save any configuration objects that use a time input field in the object configuration, such as Statistical Days, Calling Lists, Treatments, Time Zones, Routing Parameters, and Objective Tables.

To ensure that GAX works as expected, upgrade to Voice Platform plugin version 8.5.151.22 or later.

Recommendation: If you are migrating to GAX 8.5.220.20 and are using the Pulse plugin for GAX, do not use Pulse plugin version 8.5.103.01 or 8.5.103.03. Using either of these versions might cause some GAX screens to work incorrectly or not at all; in rare cases, you may be left unable to log in to GAX.

To ensure that GAX works as expected, upgrade to Pulse plugin version 8.5.103.04 or later.

In addition, after the upgrade, ensure that the following files do *not* appear in the **<GAX directory>/plug-ins** and **<GAX directory>/webapp/WEB-INF/lib** folders, deleting the files if necessary:

- jackson-annotations-2.6.0.jar
- · jackson-core-2.6.0.jar
- · jackson-databind-2.6.0.jar

Recommendation: If you are migrating to GAX 8.5.220.20 and are using the IWD plugin for GAX, make sure that you are using IWD plugin version 8.5.101.04 or later. Using an earlier version of the plugin prevents GAX from starting after the migration is complete. (GAX-8606)

For enhanced security purposes, third-party components were upgraded to latest industry standard versions, and many GAX plug-ins will not work with GAX version 8.5.270.06 if they depend on older versions of the following libraries:

- Jetty 9.2.22.v20170606
- CometD 3.0.6
- Jackson 2.9.4
- Spring 4.3.13

There is no known workaround and the issue is expected to resolve automatically when the respective plug-in component libraries are updated in newer versions of the plug-ins. To avoid incompatibility issues, if you use GAX plug-ins that use the above-mentioned libraries, it is recommended not to install this GAX version immediately but wait until plug-ins are released with corresponding updates to the third-party libraries.

ID: **GAX-9688** Found In: **8.5.270.06** Fixed In:

When Configuration Server is running in **Emergency Mode** or **Read only Mode**, the password authentication messages are not completely localized.

ID: **GAX-9644** Found In: **8.5.250.20** Fixed In:

GAX Server does not process plugin applications, such as Pulse 8.5.107.05, that send requests with an accept header that contains json, but does not include an X-Requested-With header.

ID: **GAX-9473** Found In: **8.5.250.15** Fixed In:

If password authentication rules are configured in Configuration Server at the Tenant level, existing Bulk Change Sets and new Bulk Change Sets (created by CSV files) might not work as expected.

ID: **GAX-8841** Found In: **8.5.220.01** Fixed In:

When root_url in the **gax.properties** file is set to something different from the default (/gax), the Centralized Log feature does not work.

ID: **GAX-8617** Found In: **8.5.220.20** Fixed In: **8.5.220.22**

Automatic Solution Deployment using GAX is currently limited to 2000 tenants.

ID: **GAX-8546** Found In: **8.5.220.20** Fixed In:

When using the Oracle database, the user may not be able to access the database if the name of the default schema does not match the user's login username.

ID: **GAX-8536** Found In: **8.5.210.12** Fixed In:

When GAX is used to update an object that has no configuration options in its annex, GAX displays the CFGUniquenessViolation error message, and the update is not made.

ID: **GAX-8497** Found In: **8.1.400.64** Fixed In: **8.5.220.34**

When using the Internet Explorer 9 web browser, actions in the **System Dashboard** are sometimes processed slowly or not at all, and a JavaScript error is generated.

ID: **GAX-8458** Found In: **8.5.000.86** Fixed In:

The custom date range calendar in the Centralized Logs filter is not rendered properly in the Safari 7 web browser.

Workaround: Upgrade to Safari 8 or higher.

ID: **GAX-8328** Found In: **8.5.220.20** Fixed In:

In Arabic translations, the opening parentheses (() of newly-created Operational Parameters of type Configuration Object are incorrectly displayed as closing parentheses ()).

ID: **GAX-8086** Found In: **8.5.000.71** Fixed In: **8.5.220.20**ID: **GAX-8086** Found In: **8.5.000.71** Fixed In: **8.5.220.20**

The GAX Deployment Guide does not contain instructions for passing and using an OPM in a VXML application.

ID: **GAX-8080** Found In: **8.1** Fixed In:

There is a conflict between the field length that GAX will allow for certain fields and the field length that is configured in Configuration Server. So although you enter an allowable number of characters for sections and keys of configuration options for objects in GAX, if any of those entries exceed the number of characters allowed by Configuration Server, a validation error is generated.

ID: **GAX-7755** Found In: **8.5.000.68** Fixed In: **8.5.220.20**

In non-English translations, all text of field names, placeholder values, and buttons in the **Password Change** and **Agent Deletion** dialog boxes is not localized.

ID: **GAX-7701** Found In: **8.5.000.68** Fixed In: **8.5.000.71**

A User without Write permission for Personalities cannot delete Audio Resources.

ID: **GAX-7692** Found In: **8.1.400.60** Fixed In: **8.5.000.73**

In Internet Explorer 9, GAX sometimes terminates unexpectedly if, after an unsuccessful login attempt (because you entered an incorrect password), you correct the password and try to log in.

ID: **GAX-7677** Found In: **8.5.000.68** Fixed In: **8.5.000.71**

When adding an Agent Login to an Agent, typing the Agent Login ID in the text box will result in the error Item cannot be inserted, and the ID will not be added. If you select the Agent Login ID from the drop-down menu, you do not get the error.

Workaround: To avoid this error, select the Agent Login ID from the drop-down menu.

ID: **GAX-7642** Found In: **8.5.000.65** Fixed In: **8.5.000.71**

You cannot select a **Route Type** of Direct UUI with a **Target Type** of ISCC when configuring the Access Codes for a Switch.

ID: **GAX-7462** Found In: **8.5.000.58** Fixed In: **8.5.200.12**

GAX does not check if a record has been modified concurrently by another application. When the user saves the changes to the current object, the current values displayed by GAX are saved and may overwrite the changes made concurrently by the other application.

Workaround: Refresh the GAX view to obtain the latest values.

ID: **GAX-7362** Found In: **8.1.400.64** Fixed In: **8.5.210.10**

GAX cannot configure the Application object for 8.5.x releases of Configuration Server.

Workaround: Use another application to configure the Configuration Server 8.5.x Application object, such as Configuration Manager or Genesys Administrator.

ID: **GAX-7234** Found In: **8.5.000.44** Fixed In: **8.5.200.12**, **8.5.000.71**

The selected Tenant does not persist when navigating from Configuration Manager to other views, such as Routing Parameters. For example, the Tenant selection that you make in a Capacity Rules panel does not carry over to the Configuration Manager view.

Workaround: Check the Tenant selection and, if necessary, re-select the Tenant after you navigate to a different panel.

ID: **GAX-6956, GAX-6955** Found In: **8.5.000.47** Fixed In:

The **System Dashboard** window does not work correctly in versions 8.x and 9.x of Internet Explorer.

ID: **GAX-6634** Found In: **8.5.000.44** Fixed In: **8.5.000.47**

GAX now properly creates a Statistical Day object with the specified day. Previously, if the GAX user was in a time zone before GMT, the Statistical Day was created with the day previous to the specified day. (GAX-7740, GAX-7711)
