Analyze your Business Needs

Before creating a program, gather information about the business issue you want to investigate.

Procedure

- 1. What type of interactions do you want SpeechMiner to recognize?
- 2. Determine the type of interactions generated by the business issue by listening to existing interactions about the subject or similar subjects, reading e-mails that relate to them, and consult agents who interact with customers. For example, for a customer service topic, the set of relevant interactions may only include incoming interactions about help and assistance.
- 3. Gather examples of the types of interactions you are interested in, to determine the best way to structure the program.
