About This Software

Reporting 7.6.1 consists of two products, Contact Center Analyzer (CC Analyzer) 7.6.1 and CCPulse+ 7.5.1. These products use the same underlying data sources and backend data-processing services, but differ in their data delivery and presentation capabilities.

CC Analyzer is an enterprise-class historical reporting solution featuring powerful report development tools, on-demand and scheduled report generation functions, and means of report delivery across the enterprise intranet. These advanced reporting capabilities are enabled by Crystal Reports, developed by SAP as part of BusinessObjects Business Intelligence Platform.

CCPulse+ is a desktop-level reporting application that provides both real-time and historical views of contact center operations via a Windows graphical user interface. Designed to facilitate daily resource management tasks, CCPulse+ is an ideal tool for at-a-glance evaluation of present and past contact center performance and for efficient operational decision-making.

New Features in Release 7.6.1

In February 2012, Genesys announced the End of Life of CC Analyzer 7.2, which together with CCPulse+ 7.5, composes the Reporting 7.5 release. Reporting 7.6.1 replaces Reporting 7.5.
