About This Software

Reporting and Analytics Aggregates (RAA) is an add-on to Genesys Info Mart (GIM) 8.1 providing the engine that creates and populates aggregate tables and views from the detail data stored in GIM FACT tables. These aggregates facilitate custom reporting and serve as the direct source of data for the majority of reports provided by the Genesys Interactive Insights 8.1 product.

New Features in Release 8.1.x

New features provided in Reporting and Analytics Aggregates 8.1.4 include the following:

- You can now schedule periodic purging of aggregate data, based on data age, hierarchy or query, aggregate level, and flavor.
- Queue attached data is now enabled by default: queue hierarchies now provide key columns that you can configure to join to two custom user data Info Mart dimension tables of your choice.
- RAA now provides split-media aggregation, which enhances RAA performance
 in Reporting deployments where both voice and other media are used. This is
 achieved by separating connection-oriented (online) and connection-less
 (offline) media in aggregate tables. To support this change, some aggregated
 data is now stored in AGT_* tables and presented through AG2_* views.
- Additional features introduced in release 8.1.4 are also introduced to release 8.1.1 beginning with 8.1.104, and are described in the following section:

New features provided in Reporting and Analytics Aggregates 8.1.1 include the following:

- You can create additional aggregate sets so that users can see reports in their own time zones.
- Release 8.1.104 and later: Queue attached data is now supported: queue hierarchies now provide key columns that you can configure to join to two custom user data Info Mart dimension tables of your choice. This feature is not enabled by default.
- Release 8.1.104 and later: A new aggregation runtime parameter (-

InsertPendingAgg) is introduced, which offers a simplified syntax.

Release 8.1.104 and later: A new configuration option and runtime parameters
 (materialize-subhour-in-db) are introduced that enable you to more easily
 control the materialization of subhour tables in the database.

New features provided in Reporting and Analytics Aggregates 8.1.0 include the following:

- Migration of Genesys Info Mart 7.6.005.11 aggregate data (stored in tables prefaced AG2_INB_V_*) as well as their associated dimensions into comparable aggregate tables within the Info Mart 8.1.x schema.
- A new runtime parameter that, when issued, displays the underlying queries used to retrieve data from Info Mart.
- Expansion of several hierarchies to include additional aggregated data.
