Details

Apple Push Notification server (APNs) is an Apple-hosted service that allows applications to deliver information to iOS, iPadOS and macOS devices. On March 31st, 2021, Apple will be discontinuing support for the legacy binary protocol and has instructed developers to adopt the use of HTTP/2-based APNs provider API. Information about this protocol deprecation, please refer to Apple's documentation.

If your solution uses **Genesys Mobile Services** and send push notifications with the APNs legacy binary protocol in your environment, this is a notice to all customers and partners that Genesys will stop supporting the <u>Legacy Binary protocol</u> for <u>Apple Push Notification service (APNs)</u> communication protocol for all Genesys products, effective <u>March 31st</u>, 2021.



This means that if an issue arises after this date with any existing Genesys software version that relates to **Legacy Binary protocol**, Genesys will recommend that the customers migrate to a supported communication protocol such as **Google's Firebase Cloud Messaging (FCM)**.

Please note that Genesys does not sell or provide maintenance for these services. Genesys support only refers to interoperability between these third-party products and Genesys products.
