

## Symptom

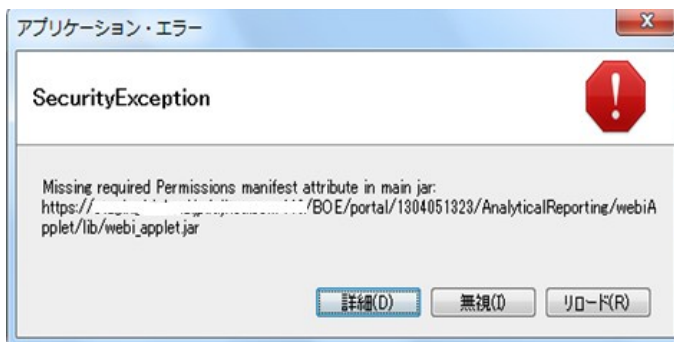
"SecurityException: Missing required Permissions manifest attribute in main.jar" error occurs after installed Java 7 Update 51

## Environment

- SAP BusinessObjects Enterprise XI 3.1
- SAP BusinessObjects Business Intelligence Platform 4.x
- Java 7 Update 51 or above

## Reproducing the Issue

1. Upgrade Java 7 to update 51 or above.
2. Create Web Intelligence document on BI launch pad.
3. The following error occurs.



## Cause

The root cause is that Java 7 Update 51 now requires the existence of the referenced permissions attribute, along with a requirement to code sign all Java applets.

The applets used by older versions do not include the permissions attribute.

This problem is identified as a product defect, tracked under ADAPT01709826.

## Resolution

A fix for this issue is included in the following maintenance releases:

### BI4.0:

- Support Pack 09

### BI 4.1:

- Patch 1.4
- Patch 2.1
- Support Pack 03

A possible workaround is to change the Java security setting from high to medium.

Another work around is to try using Java 7 Update 51's Exception Site List feature. To help with this, the following site shows how to add sites to the Exception Site List in the Java Control Panel settings.

### Add a URL

- Click on the **Edit Site List** button.
- Click the **Add** in the Exception Site List window.
- Click in the empty field under Location field to enter the URL.  
**Example:** <http://myexample.com> (**Note:** URL should begin with <http://> or <https://>)
- Click **OK** to save the URL that you entered.
- Click **Continue** on the Security Warning dialog.
