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1. Release Summary

1.1 SpeechStorm 3.4.0

SpeechStorm 3.4.0 is a regular maintenance release which addresses the following feature requests and defects:

- Updated look and feel in the Control Centre
- · Simplified mode for setting variables easily in 'Script' blocks
- Visual IVR:
 - Context passing from voice to Visual IVR channels
 - o Prompt-level CSS configurability
- Reporting:
 - o CSV download for standard reports
 - Ability to filter the Block Results report
 - o Pagination for raw data reports
 - CLI and DNIS filters for raw data reports
- 3rd Party Platform Support:
 - o Oracle 12c
 - Nuance Vocalizer 6
 - Nuance Recognizer 10
 - GVP 8.5
 - Mozilla Firefox
 - o Google Chrome
 - Microsoft Edge
 - Portico SMS Gateway
- Ability to export and import prompt wordings via Excel spreadsheets

3. New Features and Resolved Defects

3.1 SpeechStorm 3.4.0

SpeechStorm 3.4.0 included the following new features:

New Features

The visual appearance of the Control Centre user interface has been updated.

There is now a simplified mode to Script blocks to make it possible to set a variable without writing Groovy script.

New Script block API methods to allow token-based passing of variables in-scope from voice channels to visual channels and back again.

It is now possible to add per-prompt CSS customisations in Visual IVR.

Results of standard reports (e.g. "Block Results", "Business Tasks Summary", etc.) can be downloaded in CVS format.

Results in the Block Results report can be filtered to show only certain blocks of interest.

Raw call data reports can now be viewed on-screen with pagination between groups of records.

Raw call data reports can be filtered by CLI and/or DNIS.

SpeechStorm now officially supports Oracle 12c for core and reports databases.

SpeechStorm is now validated against Nuance Vocalizer 6 TTS and Nuance Recognizer 10 ASR.

SpeechStorm is now validated against Genesys GVP 8.5.

The SpeechStorm Control Centre now supports the Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, and Microsoft Edge web browsers.

SpeechStorm is tested against the Genesys Portico SMS Gateway for sending outbound messages.

TTS prompt wordings can now be exported to Excel format and re-imported again.

For convenience, prompts within the same prompt section (e.g. Initial Prompts in a Menu block) can be re-ordered using drag-and-drop.

The SpeechStorm Control Centre now runs in a 64-bit process.

It is now possible to edit all of the parameter values for parameterised callflow modules in one screen.

There is now an index on the calls.voice_platform_full_call_id database column to assist with matching records in SpeechStorm with their counterparts in InfoMart.

New Features

A new server setting permits control over whether audio files captured by a Recording block should be copied to all VUI servers.

Added support for seventeen "Silver" (Medium) level Concatenated Prompt Recording (CPR). This significantly adds to our previous CPR packs which where:

Gold (Full): English, American-English and Mexican-Spanish.

Bronze (Basic): English and French

Dynamic prompt recordings are used to playback numbers, dates, times, currencies and alphanumeric strings. This is achieved through concatenating audio files. In the Bronze (basic) CPR pack there are less than 150 audio files. In the Silver (medium) CPR pack there are between 750 -1000 audio files depending on the language. In the Gold (Full) CPR pack there are between 3000-4000 audio files.

The Silver and Gold packs expand on the Bronze pack so that fewer concatenations are necessary. This results in smoother and more natural sounding playback. The audio files are to be recorded by the customer using the same voice artist as that for the static prompts.

5.2 CPR/Dynamic Prompts

As of 3.2.0, an extra (previously missing) prompt is required for the "en-gb full" CPR prompt set:

This prompt will need to be recorded and added to any CPR zip files before uploading. If creating a new recording file is not feasible then you can create a copy of the cpr_at_f.wav file instead.

5.3 Licensing

As of SpeechStorm 3.1.3 new license keys have been introduced so it will be necessary to have any existing license keys re-signed by SpeechStorm Support for use in version 3.1.3 or later.

As of SpeechStorm 3.1.8 the number of non-menu modules that can be executed concurrently is controlled by licensing, so new 'ProductPort_productID>' license features need to be added to existing license files.

5.4 Java and Tomcat

If you are upgrading from a version prior to 3.1.8 then be aware that SpeechStorm 3.1.8 requires new versions of Java and Tomcat (see section 2). When upgrading, be sure to re-use the same 'webapps' folder from each Tomcat in order to preserve log settings and files that have been uploaded by customers (e.g. WAV files).

If you are upgrading from a version prior to 3.3.1 then you should ensure that all SpeechStorm components are running within a 64-bit version of Java and Tomcat. (The 'GUI' component in previous versions of Speechstorm was 32-bit only.) It is also required to edit the Tomcat "conf/web.xml" file in order to set the source and target Java versions to 1.8 for the JSP servlet.

5.5 Browser Support

As of 3.4.0, Internet Explorer versions 10 and below are no longer supported.

Installation of this version should only be carried out by a member of the SpeechStorm Delivery Services team.

Note that, as of 3.1.6 the database upgrade process is a two-part process. The <code>migrate.bat</code> script should be run to migrate the database schema to the latest version. Once all the Voice Servers have been deployed, the <code>Postmigrate.bat</code> script should be run to perform the required database backfill.
